

THE HISTORY OF CRANSLEY HOSPICE

Cransley Hospice provides hospice and palliative care services for the population of north Northamptonshire. Similar services for South Northamptonshire are provided by Cynthia Spencer Hospice. Both Cransley Hospice and Cynthia Spencer Hospice are managed by Northamptonshire Training Primary Care Trust.

Cransley Hospice is a purpose-built 9-bedded unit, which opened in November 1998. It has been designed to the highest possible standards and provides an ideal environment in which to care for patients. N.H.S funds underpin the cost of the Hospice. However, the Trust currently has to raise £500,000 per year, £1,500 per day, by charitable donations and fundraising activities to sustain the quality of care at a vastly enhanced level and to purchase additional services and benefits for the patients accessing palliative care services across Northamptonshire and to make their in patient stay as comfortable as possible. It is also the base for the community Macmillan Nurses who work closely with local G.P's, District Nurses and Marie Curie Nurses. The team of specialist nurses, doctors and therapists based within the Hospice provide a comprehensive service of care to the patients for whose illness cure may no longer be an option, be they in the Hospice itself, the local hospitals or in their own homes.

Every single penny raised from the 10k, Half Marathon and Fun Run will be used directly towards continuing and improving patient comfort and care.
