Leader of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nominees should be delivering activity within the borough of Kettering Leading / Coaching can either be in a volunteer or professional capacity
Volunteer of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nominees should be delivering activity within the borough of Kettering For young people & adults who have made a significant contribution to a community / club project Nominees with or working towards a relevant qualification would be at an advantage
Community School of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Schools should be based in the Borough of Kettering A school that has made a significant impact with its delivery and commitment to its local community and/or school sport, encouraging and developing students to access community based opportunities
Long-time Contribution to the Community	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nominees contribution must be within the borough of Kettering Individuals who have made a significant contribution to their community or club, and in some cases exceeding expectations of their paid / volunteer roles, over any length of time.
Team of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teams must either have a home venue, pitch, clubhouse, facility or regular use of facility within the borough of Kettering Organisations should demonstrate the successes of a particular team and put that success into context. Teams should be based in the borough of Kettering and preferably be affiliated to its Local / National Governing Body. This category applies to professional and amateur / community status teams
Community Club / Group of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clubs / Groups must either have a home venue, pitch, clubhouse, facility or regular use of facility within the borough of Kettering For clubs / groups that have made a significant impact or achievement over the past 12 months. This could be by achieving Club Accreditation, having made a significant contribution to the community or delivered a successful project that has increased participation and / or volunteering
Fit for Life Award	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nominees must live in the Borough of Kettering For individuals who has significantly improved their health & wellbeing by becoming more active
Disabled Achiever of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nominees must live, represent a club or go to school within the borough of Kettering Nominees must be registered disabled
Young Male Achiever of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nominees must live, represent a club or go to school within the borough of Kettering Nominees must have been born after 31 July 1993
Young Female Achiever of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nominees must live, represent a club or go to school within the borough of Kettering Nominees must have been born after 31 July 1993
Local Sportsperson of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nominees must live, represent a club or are based within the borough of Kettering or have represented the borough of Kettering at county level or above Nominees will be assessed on their achievements in terms of making significant progress within their sport during the past 12 months
Raising the Profile of Kettering	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Every Borough needs people who are prepared to roll up their sleeves and give a helping hand. All over Kettering, people are putting in hours of their own time, often using their own money in efforts to put Kettering Borough on the map
Outstanding Bravery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This award pays tribute to people who have done something outstanding or courageous for others
Unsung Hero/Heroine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A category for that special person who has gone that extra mile or has conquered something and deserved to be recognised for it
Fundraiser(s) of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This award will go to the individual or group, the judges have considered has made an outstanding contribution to the local voluntary sector and/or charities, either through fundraising initiatives, voluntary work or other support
<p>Sports Personality of the Year (Arthur Nicholson Award)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This award will be decided by public vote from 8th September 2011 to Midday on 22nd September 2011 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To qualify for this award individuals must have been nominated for one of the awards above in a sporting category
