Notice is hereby given, in accordance with regulation 22(3) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, that Kettering Borough Council has submitted the Site Specific Part 2 Local Plan – Submission Plan and supporting documents, to the Secretary of State for the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government on 28 May 2020 for independent examination.

When adopted the Site Specific Part 2 Local Plan will form part of the Development Plan for Kettering Borough. The Site Specific Part 2 Local Plan – Submission Plan allocates land for housing, employment and other uses. It also designates local green space, identify green infrastructure corridors and sets out policies to be applied when assessing applications for new development.
