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Representation

Loddington HVI027, HVI028 and HVI054

I wish to object to the proposal to delete the three areas of land as referenced above from their current status of Historically and Visually Important Green Space.

All three locations remain historically and visually important green space and are intrinsic to the character of the village, contributing to its existing form and character.

HVI027 (Land to the South of St Leonard's Church) contributes to the setting of a listed building, ie. Grade 2 listed St. Leonard's Church, providing unspoilt views of the church from Harrington Road.

HVI028 (Land to the South West of Richardsons Lane) was historically grazing land and contributes to the rural character of Loddington.

HVI054 (Land to the South of Loddington Hall) is vitally important in its setting outside Loddington Hall and opposite St. Leonard's Church. It forms part of the conservation area and is occupied by five magnificent mature trees.

It is of great concern that, without good reason or logic, the inspector considers that these hitherto historically and visually important open spaces should be downgraded.
