Representation

I am writing to disagree with the proposed deletion of the historical and visually important spaces in Loddington. Specifically HVI027, HVI028 and HVI054. All 3 HVI designations are environmentally important open space in the local area. Each site is an important open space with two of these being in a conservation area.

Specifically for HVI028 although it is outside the Conservation Area, it is adjacent to a Conservation Area and contributes to the setting of 2 Listed buildings and the character of the Conservation Area. Also the land contributes positively to the existing form and character of the settlement. HVI028 is central to the character of the settlement and its green and open landscape, as well as to the character and appearance of the Conservation Area and the settling of the Listed buildings for Loddington House and Loddington Farm. For these reasons I believe this site should remain as a historical and visually important local green space.

Similarly for HVI027 and HVI054 the same reasoning applies. HVI027 contributes to the setting of the Listed St Leonards Church and HVI054 contributes to the setting of the Listed St Leonards Church too and Loddington Hall. Therefore both these sites should also remain as historical and visually important local green spaces.

I strongly disagree with the proposed changes.
