#### Representation

HV1027 Loddington This Area is called the Glebe Field, as it is adjacent to Loddington St Leonard's Church. This is a Medieval Church, particularly noted for its gargoyles. It is visible from the approach to the village along Harrington Road, and obviously from Main Street. It has remained unobscured for the last 700 years, and its situation would be irreparably damaged if building were to take place on this field. This field is thought of as the village green in Loddington, and was once the Cricket Pitch. I strongly object to this change in Planning Policy, which is a desecration of a most historic building, integral to an English village.
