#### Representation

Braybrooke is a pretty village, not necessarily because of the housing stock, most of which is comparatively modern, but because of the tree lined paddocks either side of the Jordan, which divide the village in two and create its distinctive character. These paddocks have never been developed in the past as they were in the Jordan flood plane and appear on the 1767 pre-enclosure map of the village, much the same as they are today.

It is essential that these paddocks are protected so the character of the village remains unchanged. I do not want to see Braybrooke become little more than a large housing estate in the middle of the country, like so many other places.
