Representation

Dear Sirs, I would like to register my objection to the deletion of historically and visually important green space in Loddington, references HV1027, HV1028 and HV1054.

HV1054 is a small strip of land on which, I understand, is home to trees that are protected under a preservation order. A large number of trees in the village are protected which ensures that the village contributes to the national movement of conservation.

HV1027 is own by the church and is often used by local farmers to raise cattle. It is also well used by villagers excersing and dog walking. It is also used to host village events such 'Lodfest'.

HV1028 is privately owned and I understand that the current owners are in full support of the current protection. My concern is that if the protection is removed and the ownership of the land changes, the potential of the land being developed becomes a reality.

I am unable to see what the benifit of removing the protection will be to both to the village and to the local authority, unless the proposal has a hidden agenda. The protection ensures that the village retains is green spaces for the enjoyment of generations to come.
