Title	DRUGS TREATMENT SERVICES IN KETTERING BOROUGH		

1. <u>PURPOSE OF REPORT</u>

To introduce the presentation on drug treatment services in Kettering Borough.

2. INFORMATION

- 2.1 At the last meeting, the committee asked for information about the extent and effectiveness of drug treatment services in the Borough.
- 2.2. A presentation will be given by Terry Pearson from the Drugs and Alcohol Action Team (DAAT) and by Sandra Eden from Crime Reduction Initiatives (CRI).
- 2.3. The DAAT co-ordinates action to tackle drugs and alcohol problems within Northamptonshire, formulates policy on drugs and alcohol, and co-ordinates action through commissioning or influencing the development of services. The DAAT is a partnership, hosted by Northamptonshire County Council. It is accountable to the Chief Officers of the various local authorities, Clinical Commissioning Groups, Police, Probation and other key organisations in the county.
- 2.4. CRI are contracted to provide drug treatment and rehabilitation services within the County and have held this contract for just under a year.

3. <u>CORPORATE OUTCOME</u>

3.1 The presentation will describe the services currently on offer, the numbers of clients and current success rates, as well as highlighting some of the challenges facing the service at present. A question and answer session will follow.
