1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

To update the Borough Council's Geographic Forums in relation to the Community Governance Review of selected parishes in the Borough.

2. INFORMATION

Kettering Borough Council has commenced a Community Governance Review of the following parishes within the Borough of Kettering:

- o Barton Seagrave
- o Burton Latimer
- o Broughton
- o Geddington, Newton, Little Oakley
- o Cranford
- o Cransley
- o Mawsley
- o Rushton
- o Wilbarston

The purpose of the Review is to enable the Council to consider what changes, if any, are required to the existing parish arrangements to ensure that they reflect the identities and interests of the communities in the area and that they provide effective and convenient governance at the local level.

The Council is now undertaking the Review and is inviting residents, parish councils and any interested organisations, to submit their views on the existing arrangements, together with any proposals for change.

Based on consultation with Town and Parish Councils in the Borough and on the agreed criteria the Review will consider changes to the community governance arrangements, which are summarised below:

WARD CHANGES

Barton Seagrave

Barton Seagrave Parish Council has requested a change to a single eight seat parish council. (Barton Seagrave currently consists of two wards Seagrave which has 4 seats and St Botolphs which also has 4 seats).

Burton Latimer

Burton Latimer Town Council has requested a change to a single twelve seat parish council. (The Council currently consists of two wards Latimer which has 6 seats and Plessy which also has 6 seats).

CHANGES IN THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS

Broughton

Reduce the number of seats to 9 due to the difficulties experience in attracting candidates.

Geddington, Newton, Little Oakley

Consideration be given to reducing the number of councillors representing the Geddington Ward from 9 to 7 due to the difficulties experience in attracting candidates.

BOUNDARY CHANGES

Cranford

Cranford Parish Council has requested a change in the parish boundary with a view to maintaining the identity of the village as a result of the potential impact of the East Kettering development on its area and governance arrangements.

Cransley

To consider options to re-draw the boundary between Cransley and Mawsley to take account of where building in Mawsley has taken place over the existing boundary between the two parishes.
