1. <u>PURPOSE OF REPORT</u>

To ask the Executive Board to discuss and agree on the format for this year's LSP Conference

2. INFORMATION

- 2.1 Kettering Partnership held its 5th Annual Conference in October 2013 which was a thought provoking and stimulating event. £67.65 was raised for Breakthrough Breast Cancer Care and many delegates responded to the challenge to 'wear something pink' and purchase pink cup cakes.
- 2.2 The conference heard from keynote speakers including Councillors Russell Roberts and Ian Jelley, Chair and Deputy Chair of the LSP respectively; Adam Simmonds, Police and Crime Commissioner; Raf Poggi, Chair of Kettering Health and Wellbeing Panel; Cindy Wrighting and young people from Youth Works; and Trish Dewar from Groundwork with her team of volunteers.
