Dear Sir,

I understand that Wicksteed Park have made an application for a 'Premises Licence Variation' under section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003.

Name of Applicant - Wicksteed Park Ltd,
Barton Road,
Kettering,
NN15 6WJ.

I wish to object to this application on the grounds that the noise and antisocial behaviour associated with this application is unacceptable in a residential area.

I believe that granting a licence to Wicksteed Park which would allow them to play music and serve alcohol anywhere in the park until 2 A.M is completely unreasonable -

I fully understand that Wicksteed Park needs to generate income, but I do believe that it is quite unreasonable for Wicksteed Park to create what is a nightclub in the middle of a residential district. To have that nightclub potentially sited anywhere within the park perimeter is unfair on its neighbours. To have that music and alcohol environment continue until 2am, anywhere within the park environment is most unreasonable.

Living in Paradise Lane for the past thirty eight years, I have experienced at first hand how destructive having a nightclub sited in the area can be. Fortunately that nightclub has now closed down, but I do not want to see the situation develop again where I have to leave my house in the morning to deal with the vandalism + destruction to property associated with another nightclub. And if that nightclub can be created anywhere within the park's perimeter, I believe that the park are putting their own interests above those of the community they serve. I would argue that Wicksteed Park are proposing to behave in an unneighbourly fashion, and I would ask the Licensing Committee

to reject this application from Wicksteed Park
on the grounds that it is quite unacceptable
for Wicksteed Park to subject its neighbouring
community to noise untill 2am, and to subject
its neighbouring community to the anti-social behaviour
associated with drinking alcohol untill 2AM.
