






SUPERFAST NORTHAMPTONSHIRE BRIEFING ADDENDUM, COUNTYWIDE UPDATE - DECEMBER 2018

Superfast broadband coverage in Northamptonshire

Superfast broadband coverage (above 30Mbps) in Northamptonshire has reached 97.6% of premises. This compares to 95.9% in England. Ultrafast broadband coverage is 62.1%. This compares to 58.8% in England.

The County Council's target is for over 99% of premises in the county to have access to superfast broadband and 65% ultrafast by March 2021. The ThinkBroadband information provides an independent view on our progress towards meeting these targets. Further coverage and measures are being brought forward through the Superfast Northamptonshire project to help reach these targets.

The county is performing very well with both superfast and ultrafast broadband coverage exceeding the averages for England. Moreover, if characterising the respective districts and boroughs as largely urban or rural, the superfast and ultrafast broadband coverage exceeds both the UK urban/rural averages in all areas.
