On the 3<sup>rd</sup> of October 2019 Enforcement Officers from the Immigration Service visited Bryant Road Stores. The Officers encounter a male serving behind the counter, he was identified as an Indian National and an immigration offender as he entered the UK illegally.

A second male who attempted to exit the premises when Immigration Officers entered was stopped, this male had been witnessed putting stock on shelves. This male stated that he was just helping out and not working at the premises. This male was also identified as an Indian National who is an over stayer in the UK.

Both males were arrested and as no other person was present the premises was secured, one of the males was bailed by the Immigration Service once processed in custody and as of the 3<sup>rd</sup> of October 2019 the other currently remains in Immigration detention.

A Notice of Potential Liability to a Civil Penalty Notice was served by post to the Premises Licence Holder after the visit was conducted.

Northamptonshire Police would ask the Licensing Sub-Committee of Kettering Borough Council to give consideration to a suspension of the Premises Licence and the removal of the Designated Premises Supervisor.

This would be as a punitive measure to deter the premises being used as a vehicle for this criminal activity and prevent the exploitation of vulnerable individuals which also involves defrauding the revenue.

Conditions to consider once the suspension has ceased:

The Premises Licence Holder will operate a full HR management system where all relevant documents are stored for each individual member of staff.

No member of staff will be able to work at the premises unless they have provided proof of identification to right to work.

A fully working and maintained CCTV system capable of recording and storing images must be installed on the premises. The system must record at all times when the premises is open to the public and images must be stored for a minimum of 31 days. All recordings must be made available to a Police Officer or an Officer from a Responsible Authority upon reasonable request and in accordance with current Data Protection legislation. The CCTV system must cover as a minimum, all public entry and exit points, a person conversant with the retrieval and downloading of CCTV footage must be present on the premises at all times when it is open to the public.

Northamptonshire Police would point the Licensing Sub-Committee to consider paragraphs 11:27 and 11:28 of the statutory section 182 guidance that accompanies the Licensing Act 2003.

- 11:27 details what criminality should be treated particularly seriously, it details the employment of people who are disqualified from work by reason of their immigration status in the UK.
- 11:28 details that revocation of the Premises Licence even in the first instance should be seriously considered.

Northamptonshire Police would also refer the Licensing Sub-Committee to the case of R (Bassetlaw D.C.) v Worksop Magistrates, considering the points of the interests of the wider

community and punitive measures to send a deterrent message to other 5 establishments in line with this case. Further statement(s) will be submitted in line with the Licensing Act 2003 Hearing Regulations.
