

THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012

Regulation 9 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information (England) Regulations 2012 requires 28 clear days' notice to be published of the Council's intention to make key decisions.

If it is impracticable for the Council to give the required 28 days' notice, Regulation 10 (1) allows the decision to still be made if the Chair(s) of the relevant Scrutiny Committee(s) have been given notice of the matter about which the decision is to be made, a copy of the notice is made available for inspection by the public, is published on the Council's website, and at least 5 clear days have elapsed following the day on which the notice is made available for inspection by the public.
