Alcohol may be displayed throughout the store. All staff shall be trained in asda proceedures which include liquor licensing and all checkout operators and their team trainers shall have additional training in the sale of alcohol. A minimum of three members of management will be assigned to the store all of whom will hold a personal licence. There will be a minimum number of two managers on site at all times that the premsies are open for licensable activities
