

Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment - consultation document

NHS Northamptonshire has 121 pharmacies (chemists) including 9 "100 hour pharmacies" and 2 "internet pharmacies". We also have 30 dispensing doctors' surgeries (including branch surgeries), a doctor's surgery which is able to supply your medicine. They provide an increasingly wide range of services. We have asked patients to tell us what they think about the services pharmacists and dispensing doctors currently provide.

What is the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA)

By law, all primary care trusts in England must publish a Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) by 1st February 2011 which must:

- Highlight whether there are gaps in the services provided by pharmacists
- · Show pharmacists and dispensing doctors which services are required, where and by whom
- Assist NHS Northamptonshire with the commissioning of high quality services

We asked the people of Northamptonshire County:

- Which services offered by pharmacies are used most?
- Who uses pharmacies and dispensing doctors?
- · Whether people think pharmacies and dispensing doctors are convenient?
- Whether people would like more services from local pharmacies?

We wanted to know this because:

- We want to make sure that pharmacies provide services people need and use
- We want to know what services we can improve in Northamptonshire County
- We want to let pharmacists and dispensing doctors know what patients think of the services they
 provide
- We want to work with patients, pharmacists and dispensing doctors to improve services

347 people filled in the PNA questionnaire

What will the PNA be used for?

In the future PNAs will be used to determine whether applications to provide new services by pharmacists and dispensing doctors will be approved. For example, opening a new pharmacy or moving to new premises. The PNA will inform NHS Northamptonshire's overall strategic plan and help NHS Northamptonshire to ensure there is sufficient access to the services a pharmacy provides in order to meet the health needs of the population.

For the purposes of this consultation document pharmaceutical services are 'services provided by a community pharmacy (chemist) and a dispensing doctor / GP practice'.

Consultation questions

Localities

Northamptonshire County is a large geographical area made up of a number of densely populated urban areas and two large rural areas, one in the northeast and the other in the southwest. For the purposes of the PNA, we have adopted the localities defined by Northamptonshire PCT for the Joint Strategic Needs Assessment (JSNA).

These are:

- East Northamptonshire
- Corby
- Kettering
- Wellingborough
- Northampton
- Daventry
- South Northamptonshire

The reasons for using these areas are:

- · Data is readily available for these areas
- · As these areas reflect those used in the JSNA information is easier to access and relevant to all areas
- These localities' boundaries match with the local authorities' therefore making it easier to align services already offered
- We are already working in partnership with local authorities

What is this questionnaire?

This questionnaire will ask you about information contained in the draft PNA and if it accurately reflects what pharmacy services are available in Northamptonshire; access to pharmacy and dispensing services; gaps in services and priorities for developing services within community pharmacies in Northamptonshire.
