We will be mainly producers of fine quality premium spirits to be enjoyed in moderation. We will promoting a family friendly company and premises which not generally open to the public but only on the occasions of tours, tasting and mainly off trade selling. The building will be secured with bars on the windows and strong doors. We aim to promote our brand in such a way that no negativity will be associated with our operation. We will also encourage the involvement of the whole village when the occasions and opportunities arise.
b) The prevention of crime and disorder
Our premises will be securely built and we will be involved with the local public house and community to be vigilant in preventing any unwanted activities in the village.
c) Public safety
Our Distillery will have a minimal impact on the village, however we will work closely with all relevant authorities to ensure that our activities do not interfere with public safety
d) The prevention of public nuisance
Our Distillery will have a minimal impact on the village, however we will work closely with all relevant authorities to ensure that our activities do not cause any nuisance. No persons will be sold or served any alcohol if we deem them unfit and we will report them to the local public house.

We will have a policy requiring persons appearing to be below 21 years of age to provide proof of age when purchasing alcohol. We will also restrict the access of accompanied children to the distillery when we deem it necessary.

If, however, the licence also authorises the use of the premises for the supply of alcohol or the provision of late night refreshment, a fee will be required.

Schools and sixth form colleges are exempt from the fees associated with the authorisation of regulated entertainment where the entertainment is provided by and at the school or college and for the purposes of the school or college.
