3. THE RELEVANT PLANNING PERMISSION

The relevant planning permission to which this Notice relates is the permission granted by the Council on 16th August, 1991 for the alterations to the existing shop front of the said property, under reference number number KE.91.0500.

4. THE BREACH OF CONDITION

The following condition(s) has (have) not been complied with:-

Condition No. 03 which states:-

"The natural local stone shall be laid and coursed to match the existing."

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

As the person responsible for the breach of condition(s) specified in paragraph 4 of this Notice, you are required to comply with the stated condition(s) by taking the following steps:-

To remove the strap pointing of the stone facia to the shop premises and replace it with a brushed joint level with the stonework.

6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This Notice takes effect immediately it is served on you or you receive it by postal delivery.


WARNING
