ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY:

KETTERING BOROUGH COUNCIL of Municipal Offices, Bowling Green Road, Kettering in the County of Northampton.

1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there have been breaches of planning control, under Section 171(A)(a) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this Notice, having regard to the provisions of the Development Plan and to other material planning considerations.

2. THE LAND AFFECTED

Land situate off Orton Road and adjoining the new A14 Trunk Road at Rothwell in the County of Northampton as is shown for the purposes of identification only on the attached plan and edged in red.

3. THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL ALLEGED

Without the benefit of planning permission, the change of use of the affected land by the stationing and occupation of residential caravans and the use of the affected land as a gypsy caravan site.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears to the Council that this breach of planning control has occurred within the last ten years, and;


- (a) The development of this land for a private gypsy site is contrary to the policies and provisions of the Local Plan for Kettering Borough (as proposed to be modified) including policies 7, 21, 106, 107 and RA5.
- (b) The development of the site is visually intrusive, incongruous and thereby unacceptable.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

The steps required to remedy the breach of planning control are:-

- (a) The cessation of the use of the affected land as a gypsy caravan site.
- (b) The removal of caravans and associated vehicles from the affected land.

 Time for compliance: 28 days from the date this Notice takes effect.



6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This Notice takes effect on 12th December 1994 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

ANNEX

YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

You can appeal against this Notice but any appeal must be received, or posted in time to be received, by the Secretary of State before 12 http://www.1994. The enclosed booklet "Enforcement Notice Appeals - A Guide to Procedure" sets out your rights. Read it carefully. You may use the enclosed appeal forms. One is for you to send to the Secretary of State if you decide to appeal. The other is for you to keep as a duplicate for your own records. You should also send the Secretary of State the spare copy of this Enforcement Notice which is enclosed.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL

If you do not appeal against this Enforcement Notice, it will take effect on 12th

December 1994 and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period specified in the Notice. Failure to comply with an Enforcement Notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
