THIS TEMPORARY STOP NOTICE is issued by the Council, in exercise of its power in Section 171E of the 1990 Act, because they think that it is expedient that the activity specified in paragraph 4 of this Notice should cease on the land described in paragraph 3 below. THE COUNCIL NOW PROHIBITS the carrying out of the activity specified in this notice. Important additional information is given in the Annex to this notice.
- 3. THE LAND TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

Land situated at and adjacent to Hangar 1, Desborough Airfield, Scotts Lane Wilbarston in the County of Northamptonshire, shown edged in red on the attached plan.

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4. **ACTIVITY TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES** 

The use of the land for the storage of aggregates and the production of

concrete,.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Cease all the activity specified in paragraph 4 of this Notice.

WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT 6.

This Notice takes effect on 2 November 2007 when all the activity specified in

paragraph 4 of this Notice shall cease. This notice will cease to have effect on

30 November 2007.

7. THE REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

The change of use of the land has occurred within the last 10 years in breach of

planning control. The development, by virtue of the size, weight and number of

vehicle movements associated with the use, has an adverse impact on the

surrounding highway network, including the public right of way HH11 which

serves as the access to the site. The development results in the unjustified use

of open countryside for storage and industrial purposes, contrary to national and

local development plan policies.


