- On 12 October 2019 the Council has issued this temporary stop notice alleging
 that there has been a breach of planning control on the land described in
 paragraph 4 of this Notice below, as shown for the purpose of identification only
 on the attached plan edged in red.
- 2. This temporary stop notice is issued by the Council, in exercise of its power in Section 171E of the Town and Country Planning1990 Act, because they think that it is expedient that the activity specified in paragraph 5 of this Notice should cease on the land described in paragraph 4 below. THE COUNCIL NOW

PROHIBITS the carrying out of the activity specified in this notice. Important additional information is given in the Annex to this notice.

3. THE REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

No planning permission has been granted for the laying of hardstanding on the land, nor for the engineering works to level and regrade the site. The operational development that has taken place is not sustainable development and has resulted in significant harm to the openness and visual amenity of the open countryside. Any further development would exacerbate that harm.

4. THE LAND TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

Land situated to the north east side of Cransley Road Loddington (identified as NN59281 on Land Registry plan) in the County of Northamptonshire, shown edged in red on the attached plan.

5. ACTIVITY TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

Without planning permission, the formation of hardstanding and engineering works to level and regrade the land.

6. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

To cease all works for the formation of hardstanding and excavation and to remove from the site, to an authorised location, all plant and machinery and not to bring onto the land any plant, machinery and materials for creating hard surfacing or levelling the land.

7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This Notice takes effect on 12 October 2019 when all the activity specified in paragraph 4 of this Notice shall cease. This notice will cease to have effect on 9 November 2019.


